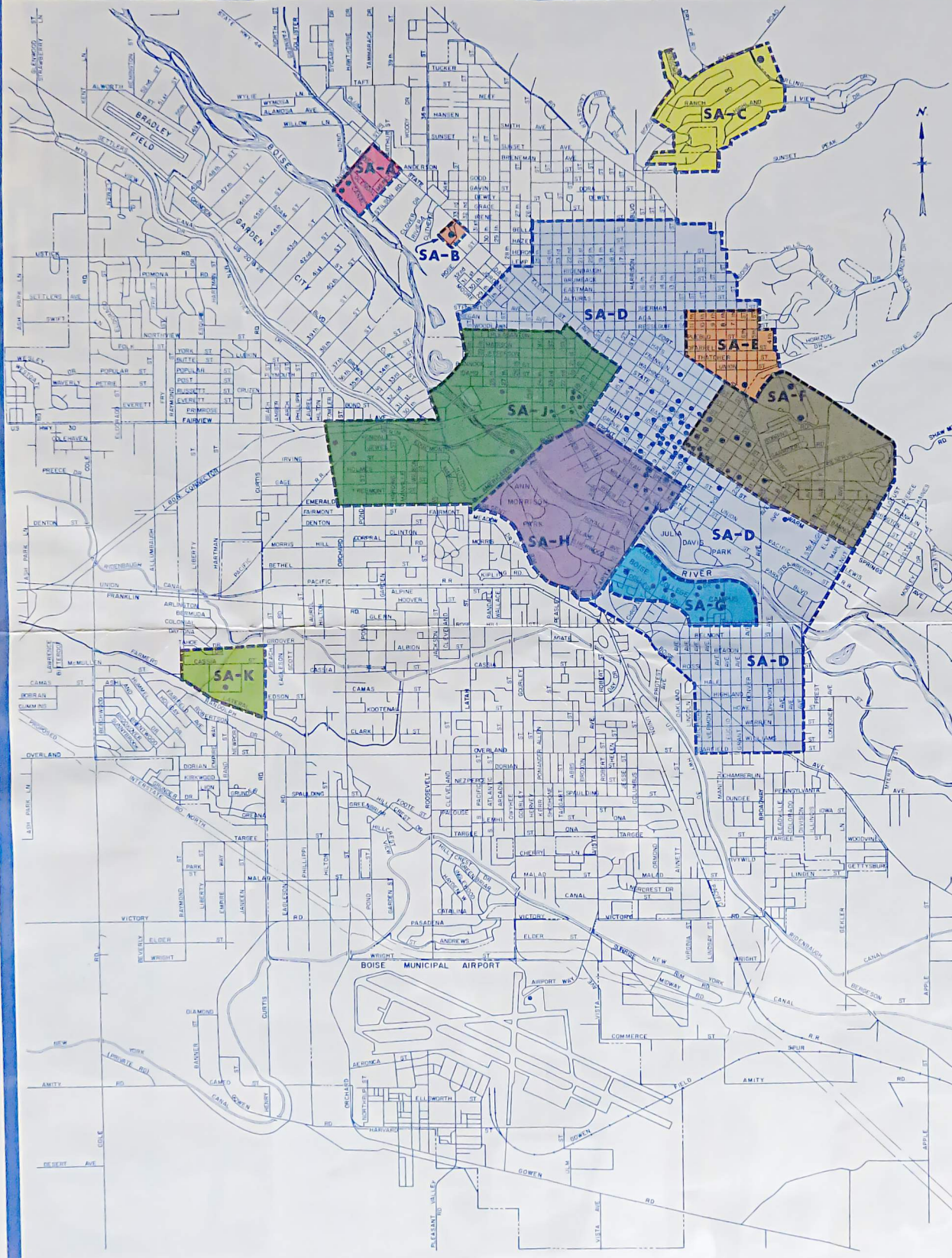


BOISE URBAN AREA SHELTER PLAN

HOW TO USE THIS MAP

To determine what to do if you are instructed to take shelter, first see if there is a public shelter available to you. To do this:

1. Find your normal day and/or night location on the map.
2. Determine from the map whether a public shelter is available to serve you. Such a shelter is available if your location falls within one of the colored areas.
3. If your location is outside of the colored area or not shown on the map, you must determine what is the best fallout protection available to you.

MOVEMENT TIME TO SHELTERS

Standard criteria for minimum movement times are thirty minutes in urban and suburban areas and sixty minutes in rural areas, plus up to fifteen minutes' warning time, with a total time available of ninety minutes. Several minutes will pass before the rural travelers reach the urban area, giving the waiting population enough time to reach their designated shelters without interfering with traffic movement. Travelers from any point in the county will be able to reach their shelter within the required sixty minute movement time. The people must not abandon their vehicles on the streets and proceed on foot. This would result in blockage of the street or highway and further loading of the terminal facilities would be impossible. In addition, all major highways and streets will remain open for maximum flow rate for firefighting equipment and other emergency vehicles during the periods immediately before and after an attack.
